Thank you for applying to The William Marshall Charity Hardship Fund. Please read the following information carefully.

1. The form must be completed in full. If you require assistance in completing the form or would like to receive the form in a different format, please contact the Clerk.
2. The Charity is only able to make payment for funds by cheques, cash and BACS payments are not available.
3. The Charity will review applications at quarterly meetings.
4. A request for funds without a purpose will not normally be granted, please make a specific request for funds, with the relevant costings.
5. Please note that the Charity has a budget and funds are limited, receipt of an application does not guarantee funding either partially or wholly.
6. Feedback on an application will not be given, although the Charity will always aim to confirm or reject an application in a timely manner following a meeting.
7. Communication between the Charity and the Beneficiary is to remain confidential; breaches of confidentiality may jeopardise future applications.
8. Where possible, aside from application for children, applicants are encouraged to complete the application form personally.
9. One of the Objects of The Charity of William Marshall is the

Relief of those living in the Parish of Welney who are in need by reason youth, age, ill health, disability, financial hardship, or other disadvantage, either generally or individually, by making grants of money to individuals, charities, or organisations for providing or paying for items, services or facilities.
